Inspired by program in SLC - rates reduced by 91% in 10 yrs


HOUSING FIRST

UPCYCLED SCRAP MATERIALS TO MAKE WOOD SCREENS TO LET IN THE SUN



problem created by reduction in housing stock

How do we shape the space to actually facilitate recovery from side effects of homelessness?

INCORPORATE SOCIAL SVCS IN A WAY THAT DIDN'T CAUSE PPL TO FEEL STIGMA:

MEDICAL, MENTAL HEALTH, ADDICTION TREATMENT SVCS

SOCIAL SVCS NOT MANDATORY NOT THE BASIS FOR HOUSING BUT INSTEAD ARE THE NEXT STEP.

AUTONOMY IS KEY!

SEEKS TO CREATE OPTIONS THROUGHOUT THE BLDGS THAT GIVE PPL AS MANY CHOICES AS POSSIBLE RELATED TO OUTDOOR & PUBLIC SPACES.

WHETHER RESIDENTS "GET IT" NOT AS IMPORTANT AS HOW THEY FEEL ABT THEMSELVES IN THE SPACE.

It is more about how people feel when they engage in a space.

Malawi

Extreme poverty
 • Less than \$2 per day
 • High maternal mortality rate (1 in 36 die during / immediately after childbirth)

PRESIDENTIAL INITIATIVE FOR MATERNAL HEALTH AND SAFE MOTHERHOOD GOAL:

- Reduce maternal mortality from its current rate to 115 or fewer per 100,000 live births
- Get more women to give birth in clinics staffed with health professionals

BILLIE JEAN KING

BILLIE JEAN KING (BORN NOVEMBER 22, 1943) WAS AN AMERICAN FORMER WORLD NO. 1 PROFESSIONAL TENNIS PLAYER WHO WON 39 GRAND SLAM TITLES. SHE ALSO FOUGHT FOR JUSTICE AND EQUALITY AND IS A PROMINENT VOICE IN THE NATIONAL CONVERSATION ON GENDER EQUALITY. WHEN SHE CAME OUT AS LESBIAN IN THE 80'S SHE AGAIN EXPERIENCED DISCRIMINATION, WHICH HAS ALSO PLAYED INTO HER FIGHT FOR EQUAL RIGHTS AND EQUALITY FOR ALL GENDERS AND SEXUAL ORIENTATIONS.




