### DESCRIPTION OF AMBASSADOR DUTIES

The Caine Ambassador Scholarship is awarded annually to select Caine College of the Arts students and is renewable for up to four years, provided a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and 12 credits per semester are maintained and the recipient participates in all ambassador functions as assigned by the college office.

As an ambassador, students coordinate with the college office to help host and serve in a variety of college events including:

- Recruitment Events
- CCA Building Tours
- Exhibitions and Performances
- College-wide or Departmental Events and Special Occasions
- Additional participation in recruitment committees and campus involvement is encouraged.

Caine Ambassadors should be well-rounded individuals who have demonstrated ability in and outside the classroom and reflect the quality of students admitted to Utah State University. Because the primary function of the ambassador program is to assist the college in events involving donors, community members, faculty, and students, ambassadors should have strong interpersonal skills, the ability to work in team environments, and display enthusiasm for Utah State.

Students who have demonstrated extensive high school/university involvement in extracurricular activities such as student government, club involvement, service coordination, and other significant leadership opportunities are encouraged to apply.

The position of Caine Ambassador carries with it a \$500 scholarship per semester. The applicant should recognize that there will be a time commitment associated with this position. Most ambassadors will devote up to 20 hours per semester to their duties with some of this time required at night or on weekends. This averages 3-6 hours per month and about 4-6 events per semester.

### APPLICATION PROCESS – DUE MARCH 19, 2021

Your application portfolio should convey your skills, experiences, and assets to the reviewing committee. Following review of portfolios, applicants may receive an invitation to interview with the selection committee. Applicants will be notified of the committee's decisions 2-3 weeks following the application deadline.

Your application portfolio must include the following:

- Application Form
- One-page resume including leadership and service experience
- One sealed letter of recommendation (a recommendation form is included with this application)
- One-page essay answering this question: *Where do you see yourself in five years, and how do the choices you're making as a student relate to your long-term goals?* Your essay should be no more than 500 words in length.
